



## McDevitt Woods Volunteer Project Overview

This volunteer event will focus on our John J. McDevitt Woods property, located on the Magalloway River in Lincoln Plantation. Nestled in the hills between Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge and the Dartmouth Second College Grant, the parcel contributes to 230 acres to contiguous conservation land that dominate the headwaters of the Magalloway, Dead Diamond and Swift Diamond Rivers.

Purchased in 2018, McDevitt woods is currently home to a privy and an unfinished cabin. With your help we will complete several projects this week that will open up user access to this property.

### Projects will include:

- Trimming and blazing the trail from the cabin to the pond
- Constructing the firepit
- Shingling the outside of the cabin
- Trimming the trees around the field and cabin
- Construct generator pad and housing

### Cell Phone Coverage

**There is no cell phone coverage.** We will be prepared with a first aid kit, and an emergency plan but this is a remote location, plan accordingly.

### Lodging

An unfinished cabin on the property is available to house up to 6 people. There is space to set up several tents, if preferred.

### Groceries

RLHT will provide the meals throughout project and cooking will be done on site. Please note any dietary restrictions during registration.

You are required to bring personal snacks. The closest towns with grocery stores and gas stations are Errol, NH (30 min.), Oquossoc, ME (30 min.), or Rangeley, ME (45 min.)

### Privy

An established privy is located near the camp. **Please note: there is no running water on site.**

### Hospital

The nearest hospital is the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH.
